<b><u>What happened when?</u></b> Create a timeline of when William Shakespeare wrote his plays. Remember that there were 37 plays in total!	<b><u>Feeling Creative?</u></b> Create a storyboard for a trailer for one of Shakespeare's plays then bring this to life using a multimedia app.	<b><u>Writing to entertain...</u></b> Write a narrative based on one of Shakespeare's plays. You can use the narrative versions of Romeo and Juliet we have looked at in school to help you.
<b><u>Who's who?</u></b> Make a one-page profile about William Shakespeare or a character from a Shakespeare play.	<b><u>"To be, or not to be?"</u></b> Learn and memorise a famous passage from a Shakespeare play of your choice. Prepare this at home and then perform this to the class!	<b><u>Set design</u></b> In a small shoe box, create a 3D set design for a scene from Romeo and Juliet.
<b><u>Heart Investigation</u></b> Set up your own fitness circuit and monitor your heart rate after each activity. Collect, record and compare your data and then present this to the class.	<b><u>Fossil of the future</u></b> Using your knowledge of how fossils are formed, design and create a fossil of the future. Think about which items humans use that might be fossilised. Be creative with how you make your fossil.	<b><u>Computing Animation</u></b> Use <a href="http://www.flipanim.com">www.flipanim.com</a> to make your own animation at home, using the skills you have learnt in school.
