<p><u>Create an imaginary creature</u></p> <p>Choose three animals and combine a part of each of these to create a new creature. What will your new creature be called? Why did you choose the three animals? What habitat do you think your new creature would live in? How would it survive?</p>	<p><u>Castle Poetry</u></p> <p>Back by popular demand!</p> <p>Write a poem or song about a knight or dragon. You could learn this off by heart to share with all your friends.</p>	<p><u>Cooking/Maths</u></p> <p>Bread was a popular food choice during Medieval times and the cooks of the castle would have baked it themselves.</p> <p>Research medieval bread recipes and get baking! Remember to measure your ingredients carefully.</p>	<p><u>Art/RSE</u></p> <p>Create a castle coat of arms to represent you as an individual. You could include things you like, hobbies or a picture of yourself on the crest,</p> 
<p><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>Create a castle scene. Think about the features of a castle that you could include.</p> <p>Choose from different media e.g. paint, pen, pencil, collage materials.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>There are lots of experiments you can conduct with eggs.
