

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

The children are expected to be well behaved at all times. Any child whose behaviour consistently gives cause for concern will be given a warning and, if their behaviour does not subsequently improve, their parents will be asked to come and collect them from the centre at their own expense.

**Please discuss the following code of conduct with your child before the trip takes place. This form needs to be returned to school as soon as possible.**

### **RULES FOR LODGE HILL**

#### **General**

- We will expect you to be well behaved at all times – in the Centre, during activities, when travelling, etc.
- If you are asked to do something by an adult in charge of you, do it quickly and without question.
- Be polite at all times.
- Remember that you are one of a large party and it will be impossible to please all of you all the time.
- Be tolerant of others.
- Be helpful to staff and other children.

#### **Centre**

- Encourage others to concentrate on their activities.
- Always walk in the accommodation block or dining hall.
- Know where your emergency exit is and where your teachers' rooms are.
- Be ready to begin activities and mealtimes promptly.
- Please be reasonably quiet when eating your meals in the dining area. You may leave the table when you are dismissed.
- Your bedtime will be decided by the adults.
- You will be told when to leave your room.
- Girls may not visit boys' rooms and boys may not visit girls' rooms.
- Keep your room tidy, as it will be inspected.
- Any damage must be reported immediately to a member of staff.
- Do not leave the accommodation block without your teacher's permission.
- You are not allowed to use the activity areas except when you have an instructor with you.
