Dear Parents / Carers









Welcome back to the second half of the autumn term. We are in a second lockdown and I know this will be incredibly hard for many in our community. I am pleased schools remain open however we will need to work together to ensure that our school stays open and that we all remain safe. Please remember the following rules:

- Please drop off and collect your child at the correct time. This is to minimise the number of people on site at one time. Please do not 'hang on' to your children and deliver them at 9am – your child will potentially be missing the important start to the day in their class. If you need to wait between times, please wait on one of the lower two playgrounds.
- Only one adult per family to drop off or collect
- All adults must wear a mask when coming on to the site. If you are exempt,
 please wear an exemption lanyard (green with sunflowers). If you do not have a
 mask you will not be allowed access to the school and your children will be escorted
 to or from you. Please leave the site promptly
- Please keep your distance when dropping off and picking up. Stay outside the marked areas at the classroom doors.
- If you, your child or anyone in your household displays symptoms of COVID-19, please do not bring your child or children to school. Keep them at home and follow the government guidance

The COVID-19 Community Hub remains open and continues to focus on helping the most vulnerable in our county, providing support, information and guidance. More details about how the Community Hub can help our vulnerable residents, their families and carers can be found on their website. But if your request is urgent, for example, you are going to run out of food or medication within the next three days, please call: **033 022 27980**.

In order to keep everyone safe in school, all staff are wearing masks in communal areas, and many are wearing visors when working closely with children. All staff are leaving promptly at the end of the day to minimise the time they are together on site.
